She is currently a staff anesthesiologist at Seattle Children's Hospital and Associate Professor of Anesthesiology at the University of Washington.

She has been teaching pediatric airway management at various levels to anesthesiology and non-anesthesiology trainees, has designed airway curricula and has organized interdisciplinary airway workshops and simulations. She has been an instructor at pediatric difficult airway workshops at the Society of Pediatric Anesthesia and the American Society of Anesthesiologists annual meetings for many years. She has been participating in and leading collaborative clinical research in pediatric airway management and is currently the Chair of the Pediatric Difficult Intubation Research Collaborative.
